Anzac Day Dawn Parade

The following streets will be closed to all traffic from 6.00am until 8.00am on Wednesday 25 April for the ANZAC Day dawn parade:

- Bowler Avenue - from Fairfield to Main Streets.
- Fairfield Street - from Bowler Avenue to Mersey Street.
- Mersey Street - from Fairfield to Main Streets.

Freeze Ya Bits Off Busking

Medway Street, Gore, will be closed to through traffic from the intersection with Hokonui Drive and the Countdown Supermarket carpark on Saturday 2 June, between 10.00am and 7.00pm.

This is to allow for the finals of the Freeze Ya Bits Off busking competition. There will be access to businesses from the western end of Medway Street via Fairfield Street.

Stock underpass

Otama Flat Road is closed to through traffic between Otamita Road and Dillon Road from 24 April until 11 May. This is to allow for the installation of a stock underpass. A detour will be in place via Jaffray, Otama and McBain roads.

The closures are undertaken in accordance with section 342 of the Local Government Act 1974.

Skateboard ban bylaw review

The Council has reviewed its Skateboard Ban Bylaw and made a change to include motorised and non-motorised scooters and longboards within the definition of a "skateboard".

As this was the only change to the bylaw and the amendment being a minor technicality, the Council exercised the discretion conferred under section 156 (2) of the Local Government Act 2002 and therefore, by resolution, it approved the revised bylaw at its meeting held on 10 April 2018.

The updated bylaw will come into effect on 1 May 2018.
