Temporary road closures

To assist with traffic flow during the 2018 Southern Field Days, the following roads will be closed from **7.00am to 9.00pm on Wednesday 14 February, Thursday 15 February and Friday 16 February:**

- Waimumu Road from Lady Charlton Road to the Glendhu Road intersection
A detour will be available via Lady Charlton Road, Kelvin Road, Duthie Road and Glendhu Road.
- Salford Street at the intersection with State Highway One
A detour will be available via Bury and Wigan streets.
