## Temporary road closures

To assist with traffic flow during the 2018 Southern Field Days, the following roads will be closed from **7.00am to 9.00pm on Wednesday 14 February, Thursday 15 February and Friday 16 February**:

- Waimumu Road from Lady Charlton Road to the Glendhu Road intersection  
A detour will be available via Lady Charlton Road, Kelvin Road, Duthie Road and Glendhu Road.
- Salford Street at the intersection with State Highway One  
A detour will be available via Bury and Wigan streets.

## Water restrictions update

Level 4 water restrictions are still in place for Gore and Mataura. This means a total ban on unattended hoses, sprinklers, garden irrigation systems and handheld hoses. Car washing by handheld hose prohibited.

The Council has stopped watering the annual flowering plots in Gore and Mataura.

The Council has halved the watering time for the hanging baskets in Gore and Mataura.

The sand arena at the Gore showgrounds is a significant community asset and will continue to be irrigated.

The Newman Park rugby fields will be irrigated next week using water from a bore, not town supply.
