

## Get your consent applications in early

People needing a building or resource consent before the Christmas / New Year break, need to lodge their application with the Council by Friday 22 November.

Our staff process applications as quickly as possible, however, there's always an influx in the lead up to Christmas.

And don't forget it's important to make sure applications have all the necessary information. If not, the application may not be accepted, or if it has been accepted, processing will be suspended until the information is provided.

## Special Licence application deadlines

To sell alcohol at events and occasions, you need to apply for a special licence. Examples include Christmas functions, race meetings, fundraisers, or sports matches.

Applications must be lodged no later than 20 days before the event. The deadlines for the remainder of this year are:

## Road closures

### Irwell Street

On Sunday 20 October Irwell Street, between Fairfield and Ardwick streets, will be closed from 7.00am until 5.00pm. This is due to activities related to the Gore Rhododendron Festival, in the Gore Gardens.

### Duke Street

Duke Street will be closed to through traffic, between 7.00am and 5.00pm, from next Monday (7 October) until Friday 11 October. This is due to contractors repairing the footpath and the narrow street preventing traffic from safely passing construction equipment.

Residents in Duke Street will be able to access their driveways via Canning Street. There will be no entry to Duke Street via Broughton Street.

### Falconer Road

Falconer Road remains closed to through traffic until Saturday 30 November, depending on the weather, while a major upgrade is being carried out. There is restricted access for residents and to businesses via Waiiau Street, including access to Transport Repairs.

### Bowmar Road

There are disruptions to traffic flow on Bowmar Road, between Charlton Road and the Charlton Park cemetery, until Friday 18 October. This is due to the felling of a stand of large macrocarpa trees. Motorists should also expect temporary road closures.

### Culling Terrace wastewater renewal

Our 3 Waters team is continuing work on the wastewater network in Culling Terrace, Mataura. It is expected to take until the end of October. To ensure public and staff safety, there are traffic lights at the top and bottom of Culling Terrace for the duration of work. Motorists can expect delays.
