

Road closures

Waiau Street Closure

Waiau Street will be closed at the northern end to through traffic from **7.00am Monday 29 July until Friday 9 August** (approximately). The closure is to allow for renewal of a wastewater pipeline outside #1 and #2. There will be access for business and property owners via Falconer Road.

Charlton Lane Closure

Charlton Lane will be closed to through traffic between #34 and #38 from **7.00am Wednesday 31 July until Wednesday 14 August** (approximately). The closure is to allow for the renewal of a wastewater pipeline.

Brennan Lane Access

Access to Brennan Lane from Medway Street will be closed from **Wednesday 7 August to Friday 9 August**. This is to allow for the replacement of a water main valve outside Conner & Fitzpatrick.

Traffic will be able to access the Brennan Lane carpark and Mersey Lane from Mersey Street, and exit on to Medway Street.

Work will be carried out at night, as well as during the day, to minimise the impact on businesses. The water supply will be shut down from 11.00pm until 4.00am to properties in Brennan and Tamworth Lanes, and the section of Medway Street from Brennan Lane to River Street.

Landslip Valley Road

Landslip Valley Road is closed to through traffic until 5.00pm Friday 16 August to allow for the construction of a new bridge.

It is closed from SH1, at Pukerau, to Burnetts Hill Road. There is vehicle access up to the construction site, but not through it. There is a temporary pedestrian bridge only for locals.

There is a detour via SH1 (Waipahi Highway), Coalpit Rd, McDonald Rd, Benio Rd, McPhail Rd and Burnetts Hill Rd. The route will be signposted.
