## Rates Rebates - there is still time to apply

The Council processes about 530 applications each year under the Rates Rebate Scheme, which it administers on behalf of the Department of Internal Affairs.

You can apply for a rebate, which is credited to your rates, if you meet the following criteria:

- You are the legal owner of the property
- you have been living at the address since the start of the current rating year (1 July)
- You have a low income or receive a benefit
