

West Gore Playgrounds Review

The Gore District Council is reviewing the future of three playgrounds in West Gore. They are **Merlin Place Playground**, **Sword Street Playground** and **Moa Place Playground**.

We propose, subject to public consultation, to remove the recreational reserve status of the Merlin Place and Sword Street reserves, and remove play equipment from the three playgrounds.

The reason for this is that historically there has been an oversupply of playgrounds in the West Gore area. The opening of the Gore Kids Hub playground added to this situation and presented us with an opportunity to review some older reserves that have outdated play equipment.

Submissions on the removal of recreational reserve status are open until **5.00pm Wednesday 14 October**.
