6. Kidzone Bus – Hokonui Radio Network and Gore Youth Council

Luke presented this proposal to 11 Youth Councillors at a special meeting on 11 June and it was agreed to go ahead with this activity.

Hokonui Radio Network will be responsible for organising this as a major promotion 23 June - 12 July 2014, but Gore Youth Council will be included in all publicity and involved with preparing 'goody bags' and accompanying winners to Kidzone on Saturday 12 July.

Approximate cost \$3,500 +GST - to come from remainder of funding allocation for running events. Payment to be made by end of June even though the activity will be held on 12 July.

23-27 June listeners will sign up via www.hokonui.co.nz, Facebook page or at the radio station for a chance to win a bus ticket. The bus ticket will get a child and a mate onto the bus.

From 30 June Luke will draw a ticket winner each morning and announce this on the Hokonui Breakfast Show between 6 and 9am. More than one winner may be drawn each morning.

On 12 July the winners and their mates and Youth Councillors travel by bus to the ILT Kidzone Festival in Invercargill, meet and greet Stags players, have lunch provided and receive a take-home 'goody bag' which will include a packet of sweets, a small packet of potato chips, a juice box, and vouchers for Movie Pass, Aquatic Pass and possibly a Mcdonalds/KFC/Subway voucher.

8. 2014 -Gore Youth Awards

Devin will address the Youth Council on the 2014 Gore youth Awards as we will begin planning for this soon.
